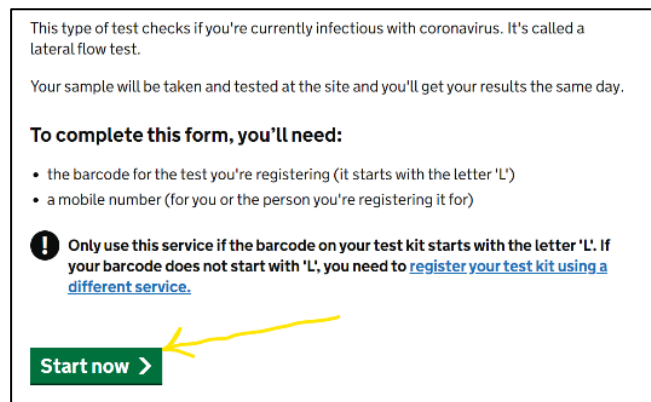


1. Open camera on your phone/tablet, focus camera on QR code on registration card. A link will appear on your phone please click on this.

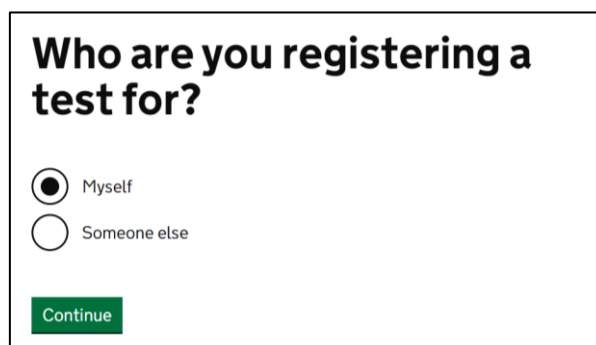


2. If your smart phone/tablet will not scan the QR code please follow this link <https://gov.uk/enter-lateral-flow-test>

3. Touch the green "Start Now" Button.



4. Students registering themselves should click "myself", parents registering their child should click "someone else".



5. Select "Register Using NHS login".

Sign up for a coronavirus testing account

A coronavirus testing account lets you save your details, so you do not need to enter them each time you register a test.

Your testing account uses NHS login. This makes it easier and quicker for you to securely access online health and care services with one username and password.

To register your coronavirus test, you can:

- use your existing NHS login details, if you have them
- create your NHS login using your email address and UK mobile phone number
- continue without using NHS login

You only need to create your NHS account once.

6. Follow the steps to enter email address and mobile numbers.
7. Create a password that meet the given criteria.
8. Agree to the data sharing terms.
9. The "Welcome to the Test and trace" message indicate you are successfully registered.

10. Click on the "register a test" link and then you will be asked to scan the barcode which is stuck to the registration card.
11. Follow the steps to enter all the information required - our test site ID is **LLSF**.
12. You will also receive a text or email notification of all results from the online NHS system.
13. **Steps 9, 10 and 11 will need to be repeated every time your child is tested.**
